(Always recite standing.)

(This prayer replaces the Angelus from Easter Sunday morning until noon of Saturday after Pentecost inclusive.)

- V. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia.
- R. For He whom Thou didst merit to bear, alleluia.
- V. Hath risen as He said, alleluia.
- R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
- V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
- R. For the Lord hath risen indeed, alleluia.

Let us pray.

O God, who by the Resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, didst vouchsafe to fill the world with joy; grant we beseech Thee, that through His Virgin Mother Mary, we may lay hold of the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
